

Contract Provisions

Handbook

I have read or will read the PWCA Student Handbook with my child. I pledge to make every effort to comply with its information at all times. I understand the dress code and agree to follow the code at all times.

Discipline

I hereby invest authority in the school to discipline my child according to the discipline procedures established by the school and further agree that I will comply by the rules and procedures for corrections. The general discipline procedures are explained in the Student Handbook. More specific classroom discipline procedures will be provided by the classroom teacher.

Damage to School Property

I understand that I will be responsible to pay for any damages caused by my student to school property (including abuse or loss of books, damage to desks, etc.).

Tuition Payments

I agree to pay tuition according to the arrangements made, and to pay all required outstanding bills before the last day of school. I understand that monthly tuition payments are due on the first (1st) day of each month and are considered late after the tenth (10th) day of the month. I further understand that a late fee will be charged on all late payments. Accounts must be paid in full by the first (1st) day of the following month in order for my student to remain in school. I understand that students withdrawn prior to the end of the school year will not receive a refund for the month in which they withdraw.

Medical Insurance

I agree to carry adequate medical insurance for my child attending PWCA.

Parent Teacher Fellowship

I agree to support PWCA's Parent Teacher Fellowship (PTF) organization and to attend PTF meetings to the best of my ability.

Home/School Cooperation

PWCA's mission involves working with the home in the overall Christian education of students. On occasion this cooperation between school and home may become difficult. To avoid such a situation, I realize the school requires parents to affirmatively support and cooperate with the school.

To that end, I agree to support the school with my prayers and positive attitude. **Complaints or negative comments will be shared only with the teacher, administrator, or person involved and not with my child or other people.** I will follow the principle of going to the person most directly involved first, then going up the chain of command as needed (teacher, principal, superintendent, Board).

I understand that if at any time the school determines, in its sole discretion, that my actions do not support the ministry, or reflect a lack of cooperation and commitment to the home and school working together, the school has the right to request the withdrawal of my child(ren).

Christian Education

I understand the Christian nature of the education of PWCA. I am willing to respect my child's decision should he or she accept Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior through the teaching of the school, therefore choosing to embrace Christianity.

This contract is binding and may not be voided except in some cases of emergency withdrawal and then only by mutual agreement between the parents/guardian and the superintendent.
